

UNBOUND-MICHIGAN MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

All Unbound-Michigan prayer ministry team members live in Michigan.

Although we welcome non-Catholics, we do submit our ministry to the Roman Catholic dioceses in which we work, so all members must agree to this supervision.

UB-MI team members respect the privacy of those we pray with and maintain confidentiality as much as possible within safe limits. If a question arises about the need to report something, they turn to Unbound-Michigan leaders and pastoral supervisors.

They live in good relationship to God's people within the context of a solid community.

They are spiritually mature; they are faithful to prayer and to the disciplines of Christian discipleship.

They are self-aware and emotionally/mentally stable.

They maintain appropriate boundaries between themselves and pray-ees.

They understand and engage the UB-MI training process.

They receive feedback from other team members with equanimity and humility.

They take responsibility to offer feedback lovingly and truthfully to fellow team members.

They come early to ministry appointments, prepared.

They respond in a timely way to communication from other team members, especially leaders.

They understand the Unbound model of deliverance prayer and commit to faithful representation of it.

They track their own progress through training and actively seek opportunities to grow in ministry skills and experience.

They have space in their lives for adequate self-care; they gracefully balance ministry with other responsibilities.

Important people in their lives are supportive of their participation on the team.

Unbound-Michigan team members attend UB-MI events as possible, fulfilling at least the minimum the participation requirement of scheduled ministry appointments a minimum of three times/six months and 1 special event/year.
